In preparing your contribution, please follow the enclosed instructions and also glance at the previous issues of the newsletter (Issue 1 - October 1977 and Issue 2 - February 1979). Follow the style employed by most contributors; not necessarily the one used by you in your previous contribution.


The scope of the Actinide Newsletter may be best defined with the aid of IAEA-186 (Proceedings of the Advisory Group Meeting on Transactinium Isotope Nuclear Data (TND) held at Karlsruhe during November, 1975). Volume I of this report contains the General Recommendations as well as the Conclusions and Recommendations of three working groups (1. Thermal reactors, 2. Fast reactors, and 3. Waste management and Isotope Applications). In addition to the topics discussed at that meeting, nuclear data on U and Pu isotopes (which were not discussed) are appropriate for the Newsletter.

The Actinide Newsletter received a strong endorsement from the participants at the Second Advisory Group Meeting on Transactinium Isotope Nuclear Data (TND) held at Cadarache, France, during 2-5 May 1979. The following paragraph appears in the draft version of the final report of that meeting.

"Much useful TND information on measurements, evaluations and computer calculations in progress has become available as a result of the publication of the TND Newsletter. The meeting welcomed the publication of the first and second issues of this newsletter and strongly recommended that it be continued to be published on an annual or bi-annual basis. The meeting also urged that scientists contributing to the general TND effort send in their contributions for inclusion in the TND Newsletter."

## INSTRUCTIONS TO CONTRIBUTORS

1. IMPORTANT Start with an oversize plain white paper and draw a box 6-5/8" wide and 9-5/8" high (16.8 cm x 24.4 cm) with a faint blue pencil. Type your contribution inside that box utilizing the full space. Final copy will be 90% of the original.
2. Contributions should be in English and carefully proof-read by the authors.
3. References to publications or reprints should be complete as required by the *Physical Review*.
4. Complete mailing address and the name of a person who can be contacted for additional information by those desiring it should be given at the end.

LABORATORY }  
LABORATORIES } Choose one

NAMES If more than one laboratory is involved, identify affiliation through abbreviations (ORNL, LASL, etc.). Visitors can also be identified with asterisks.

APPARATUS }  
ACTIVITY } Choose one; the former for experiments and the latter for compilations, calculations, or theory.

RESULTS Use this for experimental results.

INFORMATION }  
SOURCES } Use this for evaluations or compilations.

COMPUTER }  
PROGRAMS } Use this if the activity is directed towards the development of special codes.

PUBLICATIONS Use *Physical Review* style. Include only published materials.

IN PREPARATION Use this to also indicate papers submitted for publication.

OTHER RELATED }  
PUBLICATIONS } Optional

ADDRESS Mailing address. Give also telephone and telex numbers.
